What is the Annual Fund?

The CCPC Annual Fund plays an essential role in advancing our school's strategic initiatives and provides the opportunity to fund capital improvement projects, additional enrichment programs, and general support. This initiative is not just a campaign; it's a commitment to nurturing the potential of every child in our community at CCPC.

Why is the Annual Fund Important?

Throughout the school year, the Annual Fund helps make many new experiences possible for our children. A healthy Annual Fund allows us to say YES! to these special opportunities, strategic initiatives, community building events, and even some capital improvements.

How Does it Work?

Every Fall, as many families are making their decisions about December charitable contributions, CCPC invites members of the CCPC community to join in support of the Annual Fund by making a 100% tax deductible donation. With our theme of Generosity Knows No Bounds, we are capturing the spirit of our community.

Families can make a one-time gift or, for contributions \$500 and over, split their gift into two payments. Invoices for the Annual Fund will be added to the Brightwheel parent portal once the pledge is made through our CCPCWNS.com website.

What are the Goals?

Our fundraising goal is \$25,000.

In reaching that goal, we will be able to purchase new light tables for each classroom, which will allow our children to explore STEM while Learning Through Play. Although this is an ambitious fundraising goal, we are hoping that your Generosity Knows No Bounds.

We are striving for 100% family participation.

Did you know that over the last two years we have had 100% participation in the annual fund by CCPC staff? Yet, our highest peak of family participation in the past has been 77% - we can surpass that this year.
